Information Bank

Simple present tense identifies something that happens in the present and it may happen more than once.

e.g.

**I walk to school.
She kisses the boy.**

Use the Simple Past to express the idea that an action started and finished at a specific time in the past.

e.g.

**I walked to school
She kissed the boy.**
