PERFECT PAST AND PRESENT

The present perfect is used to indicate a link between the present and the past. The time of the action is before now but not specified.

e.g. I have danced.

The past perfect indicates that an action was completed (finished or "perfected") at some point in the past before something else happened.

e.g. I had danced.
